- Diana's fav is **Linex** from Nashua Creative Focus. It's a beautiful cotton/linen blend that combines the feel of linen with the price of cotton that can't be beat! With generous yardage and gauge of 5 stitches/inch it is perfect for a summer cardigan or pullover.
- Judith thinks "Eucool is cool." This DK weight wool/eucalyptus yarn is perfect for 3 color domino knitting. The fibers cling to each other, making weaving in ends as you go a breeze.
- Patrick is making the most glorious vest from **Nordique** by Classic Elite. It has awesome colors in a nice grabby wool best for Fair Isle.
- Beverly is fashioning a delicate lace scarf from **Kami Bison** by Fibre-Isle. It's a sweet blend of bamboo, merino and bison that drapes, shines and caresses the skin.

Counting tip: when casting on a large number of stitches, don't count & recount the same stitches. Place markers every 10, 20, 50 or whatever stitches for easy set up. It saves you lots of time and frustration. And you are also more likely to begin with the right number of stitches.
